The earthquake was the strongest to hit Haiti in 240 years, leaving the capital of Port-Au-Prince—10 miles from the epicenter—all but destroyed. The death toll is thought to be in the tens of thousands—



perhaps as many as 200,000, according to the president of Haiti.

The SBCV, in partnership with NAMB and many other state conventions, launched the Buckets of Hope project to serve the victims of the earthquake. In

Matthew 25:40, Jesus said, "And the King will answer them, 'I assure you: Whatever you did for one of the least of these brothers of Mine, you did for Me.'" (HCSB).

Buckets of Hope are just one means by which Baptists are fulfilling the mandate of Jesus Christ to feed the hungry in His name. At the time of this publication, the buckets have been collected and are being delivered to victims in Haiti.
